WHAT A team-based scavenger hunt fundraiser benefiting Clinic by the Bay, a local nonprofit providing free healthcare for people without insurance

WHEN Saturday, December 2nd, 2017
3:00 PM –6:00 PM (check in starts at 2:00 PM)

WHERE The hunt takes place in a 1 square mile area of downtown San Francisco, starting at the Embarcadero

HOW

Fundraising Before the event, teams fundraise at least \$300. Teams can use online fundraising pages provided by the Clinic to crowdfund, host a small fundraiser, and/or donate themselves. Clinic staff will provide tips & help!

The Hunt The day of the event each team will receive the list of clues to solve at check-in, the team that solves all the clues first will win a trophy and bragging rights

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Q: Can our team just pay the \$300 instead of raising it?

A: Yes. But this event is a fundraiser and we're hoping to raise a good amount of money towards our mission of providing high quality, free healthcare for the working poor.

Q: Where does the money raised go?

A: All donations are tax deductible and go to support Clinic by the Bay in its mission to provide volunteer-driven, free, high quality healthcare to the working poor in San Francisco and San Mateo counties. More information can be found at: www.clinicbythebay.org

Q: What do we get if we raise more than \$300?

A: Once your team has raised \$500, you will be given a hint to help you complete the race. You will get a second hint—for a harder clue—once your team raises \$750. And you will get a final hint—for a harder clue—once your team raises \$1,000. Finally, the team that raises the most money overall will win trophies!

Q: What else do we get?

A: All race participants will get a commemorative t-shirt (sure to be a collector's item!). The team that gets the most clues right, in the fastest time, will receive trophies. The team that raises the most money will receive trophies. And, most important of all, you will receive the satisfaction of supporting a great cause—with all the resulting good karma!

Q: Will Clinic by the Bay help us with fundraising?

A: Of course! We will provide dozens of examples of easy things to do to raise money, and we will also provide a web page, specific for each team, where people can donate to your team, will track money raised to date, etc. We will also periodically "feature" various teams through social media, our website, etc.

Q: What if we get tired and don't want to finish the race?

A: Of course we encourage all teams to finish, but if you get stuck, or team members decide they're too tired to continue and want to stay in North Beach to go out, or grab a bite in Chinatown, etc., you can stop. However, to be eligible to win the race, all team members must return to the starting point to officially register their completion/time/number of clues found.

Q: How hard are the clues?

A: Some clues are easy, a few are hard, and most are in between. A good mix of team members will help, as will using the provided map & street index well. Having folks who are good at riddles/puzzles will help, too, as well as good general knowledge of current events, literature, history, and popular culture.

Q: How physically demanding is the hunt?

A: The answer to this depends on how much you want to win the race! A strong team, working hard and running from clue location to clue location could finish in 2 hours. Some will need the whole 3 hours, and some teams may not finish within the allotted time to be eligible to win the race.

Q: Can we get outside help?

*A: Yes, BUT! Your team **MUST** stay together during the hunt and must return all together at the end to be eligible to officially win the race. You can use google to help find clues, you can "phone a friend" to help/give suggestions, and you can ask people on the street for help. Also, the hunt **MUST** be conducted on foot.*

Q: What do we need to bring on the day of the hunt?

A: At check-in, you need to show at least \$300 raised by your team through online donations already received and/or cash & checks brought the day of the event (we will also have credit card capability for last minute donations) in order to get a clue sheet and map. You should also wear comfortable shoes and bring a spirit of adventure and fun.

Q: Anything else?

A: Recommended items to bring: smartphone, flashlight, water/snacks, and a clipboard or other small hard surface to make it easier to write on your clue sheet.
